Today, the SPA continues to protect and beautify the area while building a community through neighborhood events, regular information meetings, beautification/tree planting, police patrol and much more. What Did The SPA Do In The Last 12 Months?

- Proactively lobbied the city for increased Stamford Police Department patrols of Shippan Point, particularly in light of recent thefts from unlocked cars.
- Sponsored 228 hours of extra police patrols during the most critical periods of the year.
- Created Facebook communities for Shippan residents to share concerns, ideas, and questions. Also provided informational email updates to members and a welcome letter to new residents.
- Continued beautification efforts by planting trees along roadways, including an evergreen (to light during the holidays) at the entrance to Shippan Point.
- Hosted two Government 101 Meetings. The 2018 event featured Earl Kim, Superintendent of Stamford Public Schools. In 2019, the SPA hosted Matt Quinones, President of the Stamford Board of Representatives, and David Watkins and Bradley Michelson, our District 1 reps.
- Held annual meeting to review financials and discuss safety and security on Shippan Point.
- Worked with elected representatives to aggressively pursue improvements that benefit all Shippan residents such as the retiming of traffic lights in and around Shippan Point.
- Organized, sponsored or assisted in a number of community events, e.g. the Annual Community Tag Sale, Children's 4th of July & Halloween Parades, Annual Celebrate Shippan, Music in the Park, Wine Tasting, and 2nd Annual Dog Parade.

Holiday Dog Parade

Shippan Point is always a great place to walk dogs but it got even better when dogs and their parents joined in our second annual Holiday Dog Parade and Fundraiser. Over 40 pups and their humans strolled from the ALC beach to the Downs Avenue home of Russell and Dayanne Liner. Parade goers enjoyed donuts, coffee, and cider at the end of the walk, while the doggies appreciated treats donated by Pet Pantry Warehouse. Over \$545 was raised for Project Precious Rescue, whose mission is to provide veterinary care, food, and foster homes to pets whose caretakers can no longer care for them.

Police Patrol Fund

Shippan is one of the safest neighborhoods in the city and we want to keep it that way! So the SPA is in frequent contact with the Stamford Police Department to communicate our needs and concerns, and advocate for strong police coverage in Shippan. In addition to regular policing, the SPA contracts for over 228 hours of supplemental police patrols, predominantly in the busy summer months. These patrols are funded by Shippan Point residents, through donations to the SPA Police Patrol Fund. These patrols help keep our neighborhood safe and protect our quality of life through enforcement of laws and ordinances regarding: loitering, speeding, parking restrictions, disturbing the peace, etc. Dozens of parking violations and several arrests for narcotics and motor vehicle violations were made during SPA sponsored patrols. The suggested Patrol Fund donation is \$70 per family. You do not need to be a member of the SPA to donate to this dedicated funding account.
